



## City of Norfolk/SPSA Application for an Additional Recycling Cart



Citizens of Norfolk that live in residences with 4 units or less qualify for the curbside recycling program with a 95-gallon cart collected every other week. You may request up to one additional cart if your family regularly exceeds the capacity of one cart. In order to receive an additional recycling cart, a household member must complete this application and be approved by Keep Norfolk Beautiful. Once your application is approved, you will be notified by recycling staff and an additional cart will be added by SPSA (Southeastern Public Service Authority) to your residence. This process helps us to better manage your recycling collection and the carts issued. Carts will be provided based on availability.
